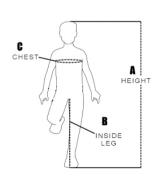

Please refer to the following chart. Measurements A) and B) must be taken whilst WEARING OUTDOOR SHOES





Note: For a person with a normal bone structure, the inside leg will generally equal half the height, less 2cm for a slim person or 5 cm when heavily built. For example, a slim person of 100cm, would have an inside leg of 48cm (100cm /2 = 50cm less 2cm = 48cm). Use this formula to cross-check your measurements! A book used as shown will help you achieve an accurate measurement, but try to get the longest inside leg possible. Measure them wearing outdoor shoes but without a nappy.

PLEASE READ THESE IMPORTANT NOTES ON DRIVE TYPES, THEN ANSWER THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS CAREFULLY

FIXED WHEEL: there is a direct connection between pedals and wheel - the wheels and pedals are locked together.

FREE WHEEL: the wheels can turn even when the pedals are not turning for example when coasting downhill, however, he/she will normally have to pedal to propel the trike.

MULTI SPEED: multi speed trikes are similar to free wheel trikes but have a range of speeds (5 or more gears).

The rider has a PROVEN ABILITY* to:

16 - Pedal a FIXED WHEEL trike

19 - Brake a trike or bike safely and quickly

17 - Pedal a single speed, FREE WHEEL, trike or bike

20 - Steer a trike or bike accurately, for example through a narrow gate or avoiding pedestrians

18 - Pedal a MULTI SPEED bike or trike

21 - Pedal a trike or bike without foot-support

* <u>VERY IMPORTANT</u>: Only answer "YES" if the rider has a PROVEN ability with the tasks 16 to 21. Otherwise answer NO or I DON'T KNOW. Do not enter what you would like them to be able to do, but only what you KNOW they can do.

22 - Preferred colour (please refer to the following chart colours):

22A - RED

22B - PINK

22C - BLUE

22D - LILLAC
